ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I

The name of this organization is The MEDHOSPITAL FOUNDATION

ARTICLE II

The purpose for which this organization exists:

- A. Help the families and children by empowering them with awareness of health and medical help.
- B. To do research and educational studies to create a model information structure that ensures easy access to reliable health information.

ARTICLE III

This organization is an independent, non-profit, non-governmental organization run and governed by BYLAWS created by the Founder and agreed upon by the rest of the members.

ARTICLE IV

The address of our head office is 2552 Renshaw Dr, Troy, MI 48085.

ARTICLE V

This organization is a benevolent corporation, and therefore its term is unlimited and in perpetuity.

ARTICLE VI

The Medhospital Foundation Members may establish one or more classes of non-voting members, donors or benefactors, with designated privileges for each class. Founder is the only member who is not elected. The existing members elect all new members by vote of a majority. A person shall cease to be member upon his death, or upon his resignation or removal as provided by the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VII

All property of this organization and accumulations thereof shall be held and administered to effectuate its purpose and to serve the general welfare of the people. Upon the dissolution of this Foundation, the executive committee will after clearing all liabilities of this Foundation, dispose of all the assets of this Foundation exclusively for the purposes of this foundation in such manner as the Members of the Foundation shall determine.

These Articles of Incorporation were duly adopted on the 8th day of December, 2005.
